

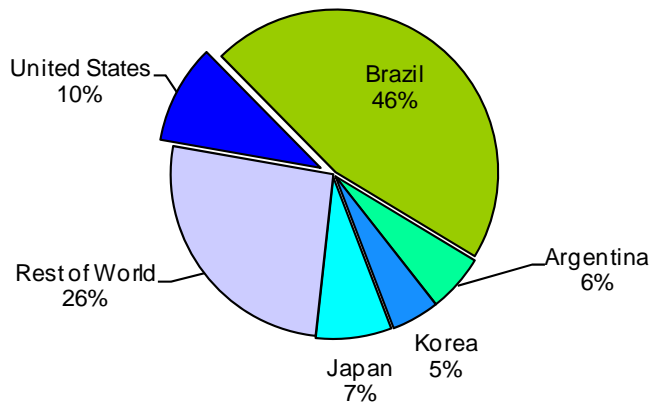


The United States Contributes to Economic Prosperity in Bolivia

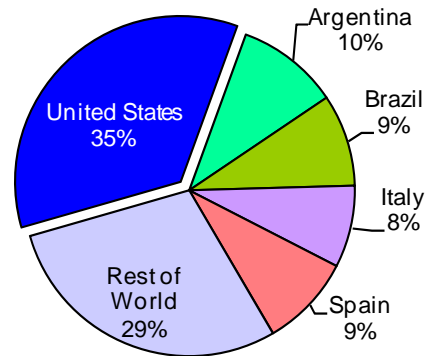


- In 2007, U.S. direct investment in Bolivia reached \$262 million (BEA, *Survey of Current Business*, Sept. 2008); this is equivalent to nearly 2 percent of Bolivia's GDP of \$13.2 billion (World Bank, *World Development Indicators*).
- The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) provided over \$72.6 million in aid to Bolivia in 2007.
- The United States purchased nearly 10 percent of Bolivia's total merchandise exports in 2007 (IMF Direction of Trade).
- U.S. merchandise exports to Bolivia were \$277.7 million in 2007.
- In 2007 over \$1 billion in remittance money was sent by Bolivians living abroad (Inter-American Development Bank).
